

Flagship 4 2013 Focus areas

5 year target: CBDRR activities in 1000 VDCs/municipalities

2013 target: 750 of the targeted 1000 VDCs/ municipalities will be undertaking CBDRR activities

2013 Main focus areas

- Promote communication and coordination between Flagship 4 and its members
 - Develop real-time sharing mechanism (online forum)
 - Bi-monthly meetings with partners led by MoFALD
- Further the discussion on Urban DRR and establish Nepal Urban DRR information portal
 - Platform and google group
 - Support the adaptation of current CBDRR guidelines to include Urban DRR
 - Include 1 thematic workshop in November
- Further operationalize minimum characteristics
 - Flagship 4 handbook to include:
 - § 27 case studies
 - § Background on how the 9MCs were formed
 - § Publish in both English & Nepali
 - Work with DIPECHO VII partners in their CBDRP model to operationalize and test 9MCs
- Increase data collection & setup online GIS mapping accessible to all,
 - project tracking survey, to gain a better understanding of what is happening on the ground.
 - Project registration data: # beneficiaries, financial information
 - DRM mapping
 - potential to use data for retrospective study on CBDRM and gap analysis
- Advocacy of CBDRR tools be included in implementing partners trainings and program (a more sustainable approach to the district consultations of 2012).
 - Continue to provide training to facilitators and update training materials

Other areas

- Increase connection with researchers and availability / accessibility of results to practitioners and community members
- Broaden DRR discussion into other sectors such as Education, Health and Climate change
 - Increase collaboration with other flagships
- Support the strengthening of technical and thematic areas:
 - Including support on workshop on the science to practitioners and community level
 - Thematic workshop on insurance and insurance risk modeling.
- Support the coordination with EWS and Ncell, as well as linking in with National EWS forum
- Contribute to regional level inclusive models for CBDRM

Challenges

- Gathering data ie. organizations completing project tracking survey
- Availability of resources (both human and financial)
- Willingness of other sectors to discuss DRM
- Development of relevant example indicators
- CCA & DRR linkages particularly at policy level
