What next??

NRRC Communications group will begin developing common messages for fire hazard and common multi-hazard messaging. Note, all messages will continually require revision and updates as we get a better understanding of their effectiveness.

What to do with these messages?

These messages are designed to be used by all stakeholders working with communities, incorporated into promotional materials on disaster risk reduction. They can also be used by media outlets when talking about actions communities before and after a disaster

Who are using these messages so far?

The Nepal Red Cross will be incorporating the earthquake messages in their Earthquake Preparedness and Safety Program, while USAID has been using these messages for their PSAs (<http://youtu.be/40nkffRC2Jw> for the latest one). In addition, the DIPECHO partners will be incorporating common messages for floods and landslides into their programs.
