- What impact has the implementation of the 9 minimum characteristics of a disaster resilient community by implementing partners had at the community and VDC (ward*) levels?

	Outcome indicator	9 Minimum characteristic
1	DMCs are able to self organise and committee members representing minority groups are able to articulate examples of successfully tabling issues that have resulted in decisions.	1, 2, 3
2	Disaster Management Committees (DMCs) are able to secure resources for DRR/M activities	1, 5, 6, 7
3	Communities are informed and aware of disaster risks, have made preparations to respond and understand what action to take when responding	2, 4, 5, 9
4	Quality of response to disaster events has increased, relative to previous years (including decreased response time)	4, 9, 5
5	Communication between local government structures and communities is regular and results in increase in lead time, relative to previous years	1, 2, 9, 4
6	Risk reduction activities have been implemented, are reflective of community's needs, are maintained and are viewed as reducing risks	3, 8
